

Lab Manager Position Opening at Yale University

The Yale Cognition and Development Lab, under the direction of Professor Frank Keil, anticipates a Lab Manager position opening beginning in July 2008. This position involves hands-on research opportunities in the fields of cognitive and developmental psychology.

Responsibilities:

The Lab Manager (i.e., RA) conducts research-related tasks for projects investigating cognition and development in preschoolers, school age children, and adults. Additionally, the RA sets up and maintains liaisons with greater New Haven area schools and preschools, interviews children in those settings according to research protocols, recruits children and their parents, ensures they arrive to the research center at Yale, and interviews them. Furthermore, the RA aids in the design of stimuli, the scoring and entering of research data on computer, and in the analysis of collected data.

Experience and Training:

Competitive applicants will have a bachelor's degree in either a natural or social science area. Prior experience in experimental psychology research, especially with children, is an asset. Course experience in cognitive or cognitive science is preferred. A genuine interest in the lab's research questions is highly desired.

Benefits:

The full-time position carries a competitive salary as well as health care benefits. It also provides excellent experience for students considering attending graduate school in psychology.
