from Erie. 79 S to (EXIT 78-77) PA Turnpike (I-76) EAST to New Stanton EXIT (EXIT 75). Get on 119S toward Connellsville. Travel about 40 miles on 119S. 119S becomes 40E/National Pike. Turn right from 40E/National Pike into Fort Necessity National Battlefield and to Visitor Center
from Philadelphia. PA Turnpike (I-76) WEST to New Stanton EXIT (EXIT 75). Get on 119S toward Connellsville. Travel about 40 miles on 119S. 119S becomes 40E/National Pike. Turn right from 40E/National Pike into Fort Necessity National Battlefield and to Visitor Center
from Pittsburgh. PA Turnpike (I-76) EAST to New Stanton EXIT (EXIT 75). Get on 119S toward Connellsville. Travel about 40 miles on 119S. 119S becomes 40E/National Pike. Turn right from 40E/National Pike into Fort Necessity National Battlefield and to Visitor Center
